#### **Onwards to March 2019**

Dear iHub supporters,

Happy new year. It promises to be a very exciting one, with our ARENA funding submission progressing now to the final phase of approvals.

The iHub team submitted the revised "stage 1" proposal in November, and then pitched it to the ARENA Advisory Panel on Wednesday, December 5. We have since been provided with positive feedback from the committee, and we now expect the proposal to progress to the next full ARENA Board meeting for approval in March.

This is very good news!

In the meantime, we will be developing our work plans and governance structures further so we can hit the ground running for a possible mid-year launch.
